Fall Scholarship Application

PART-TIME STUDENT

Bridging the Dream is a scholarship program established and funded by the PTC Foundation through donations and fundraising efforts. A part-time student is eligible for a scholarship in the amount of \$300.

All applicants must:

- Be a new or returning student at PTC with a stated major, registered for or planning to register for 3-11 credits Fall Semester.
- Use these funds for tuition and fees only.
- Submit a written acknowledgement to the scholarship provider outlining the use of the scholarship and its impact on his/her educational progress.
- Apply by completing application form in its entirety, including all essay questions on the reverse side of this form. The applicant's signature implies agreement to all stipulations of the scholarship.
- Recipient must attend a donor recognition event.

Scholarship Award and Distribution

- The deadline for completed applications is July 6th, 2009. *No exceptions.*
- Notice of award will be sent to recipients by July 24th, 2009.
- Students who receive a scholarship must pick up their donor's name and have thank you letters returned to the President's Office by September 4th, 2009. *No exceptions.*
- Actual distribution of funds will be made through the PTC Business Office, upon approval of Foundation Board, on October 2nd, 2009. If you owe anything, the scholarship will be credited to your account. If not, you will receive a check via US Mail. While any prospective student may apply, funds will be awarded only to those actually enrolled for the Fall Semester.
- If you are a part-time student upon submission of this application, and you change your status to full-time, you will only receive a part-time scholarship if awarded.

Application Procedure

If you meet the above criteria, please fill out the information below and submit it to the Financial Aid Office in person, by mail or via fax 320-629-5101. Applications must be complete, signed, and submitted on or before the stated deadline date. No exceptions.
