E-mail communication with E-LECT classes

It is imperative E-LECT students establish, check and use a reliable e-mail account for communicating with instructors since courses are delivered in an online format, and e-mail is a common method of communication among students, staff and instructors. Students are to avoid using commercial accounts such as Gmail or Hotmail; instead students are to use an official college e-mail address, available at their home campus. For example, E-LECT students whose home campus is Pine Technical College will use an official PTC student e-mail account for communicating with all instructors. (PTC students must stop in to set up this e-mail account initially.)
