

## **Electronic Engineering Technology Scholarship for Underrepresented Students**

A one-time fund within the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Foundation, the Electronic Engineering Technology Scholarship for Underrepresented Students is designed to provide support to underrepresented students pursuing a degree in electronic engineering technology at select two-year colleges and state universities within the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system. Four scholarships will be awarded for the 2010-2011 academic year: two \$1,500 awards for university students and two \$1,000 awards for two-year college students.

The criteria for the Electronic Engineering Technology Scholarship for Underrepresented Students are as follows:

- Underrepresented student pursuing an associate or bachelor's degree in electronic engineering technology
- Full-time student registered for no less than 12 credit hours for the fall semester at Bemidji State University, Minnesota State University, Mankato, or one of the following two-year colleges: Anoka Technical College, Hennepin Technical College, Lake Superior College, Minnesota State Community and Technical College (Wadena campus), Minnesota State College-Southeast Technical, Northland Community and Technical College, Pine Technical College, Ridgewater College, St. Cloud Technical and Community College and Saint Paul College.
- Grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Financial need as determined by the university or college financial aid office
- Letter of recommendation from a electronic engineering technology faculty member or department advisor

In regard to the term "underrepresented," the Foundation applies the system's definition as found on the Diversity and Multiculturalism division's Web page:

**UNDERREPRESENTED STUDENTS:** This group includes underserved students (African Americans/Black, Asian, Hispanic, American Indian and multiracial) plus first generation students and low income students. (In specific instances, other groups of students may be considered underrepresented. For example, in a traditionally female discipline, males may be considered underrepresented.)
